Korean Pilots & Association

- 266 Korean Pilots (1women) works in 12 branches
- Apprentice pilot requirement : experience as Capt. more 6,000 GT
 M/V with 3 years more (competition average 8~10:1)
- Min. 200 training for 6months → Final Test → Get a license by Government & Work as Individual Business (Self-employed pilot)
- Pilots & Association(established 1977) works based on Korea Pilotage Act





Pilots in Korea Marine Industries

- Top 13 of world GDP rankings (2022)
- Top 6 of world marine industry rankings (2022)
 with 1,718 vessels and 4% of market shares
- Korea's International trade is 63.51% and 99.7% transported by ship
- Top 3 currency import factor in Korea, 35 trillions
 (1st Semiconductor 130 trillions, 2nd Automobile 47 trillions)

- As trade volume increased, the number of pilots dramatically bigger
- The government could set an "em'cy port system" by designating 20% National essential pilots(2018~) to work for national em'cy




